Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

The Apostles Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

Or Psalm 70:

“O God, come my assistance; O Lord, make haste to help me.”

The Our Father Prayer

(Opening, then at the beginning of each decade.)

Our Father, Who art in heaven; hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

The Hail Mary Prayer

(First three small beads. Intentions of the Holy Father. Hope, Faith, and Charity) * then as per each mystery in the following pages for each bead on the decade.)

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.(*). Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

The Glory Be Prayer (The Doxology) (and at the end of each decade)

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

The Fatima prayer (end of each decade)

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins. Save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven especially those in most need of Thy mercy.

Concluding Prayer(end of each decade)

Each decade has a specific concluding prayer that is recited to emphasise the fruit of the mystery. They are included in each of the following pages.

The Hail Holy Queen Prayer (At the end of the rosary)

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope, to thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this vale of tears; turn, then most gracious Advocate, thine eyes of mercy towards us, and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary! Pray for us, O holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

"Let Us Pray" From the Breviary (At the end of the rosary)

Let us pray, O God, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death and Resurrection, has purchased for us the reward of eternal salvation. Grant we beseech Thee that while meditating upon these mysteries of the most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

The Saint Michael Prayer (At the end of the rosary)

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in the day of battle. Be our safeguard against the wickedness and the snares of the devil. May God rebuke him we humbly pray and do thou O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl throughout the world seeking the ruin of souls.

THE FIRST JOYFUL MYSTERY

THE ANNUNCIATION

*Example of an individual Hail Mary with meditative phrase added: Hail Mary full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed are thou among women and blest is the fruit of thy womb Jesus, *who was conceived in you by the Holy Spirit. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen. (* will be different for each mystery)*

Our Father ...

1. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shined.

**who was conceived in you by the Holy Spirit. (Is 9:2)*

2. Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Emmanuel.

who was conceived in you by the Holy Spirit. (Is 7:14)

3. Steadfast love and faithfulness will meet; righteousness and peace will kiss each other. Faithfulness will spring from the earth, and righteousness look down from heaven.

3. Sing for joy, O heavens, and exult, O earth; break forth, O mountains, into singing! For the Lord has comforted His people, and will have compassion on His afflicted.

4. Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion; for lo, I come and I will dwell in the midst of you, says the Lord.

who you carried to Elizabeth. (Zec 2:10)
5. A voice cries, "In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God."

who you carried to Elizabeth. (Is 40:3)
6. They shall come and sing aloud on the heights of Zion, and they shall be radiant over the goodness of the Lord.... I will comfort them, and give them gladness for sorrow.

7. My deliverance draws near speedily, my salvation has gone forth, and my arms will rule the peoples; the coastlands wait for me, and for my arm they hope.

THE THIRD JOYFUL MYSTERY
THE NATIVITY

Our Father ...

1. A Child is born to us, and a Son is given to us, and the government is upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, God the Mighty, the Father of the world to come, the Prince of Peace.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Is 9:6)

2. For while all things were in quiet silence, and the night was in the midst of her course, thy almighty Word leapt down from heaven from thy royal throne, into the midst of the land that was doomed.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Wis 18:14-15)

3. Before she was in labor, she gave birth; before her pain came upon her, she was delivered of a Son.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Is 66:7)

4. Comfort, comfort my people says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her, that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Is 40:1-2)

5. Be still, and know that I am God. I am exalted among the nations, I am exalted in the earth! The Lord of hosts is with us, the God of Jacob is our stronghold.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Ps 46:10-11)

6. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God...; and I heard a great voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling of God is with men."

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Rv 21:2-3)

7. Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Jer 23:5)

8. And while they were there, the time came for her to be delivered. And she gave birth to her first-born Son and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger because there was no place for them in the inn.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Lk 2:6-7)

9. And in that region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with fear.

who was born to you in Bethlehem. (Lk 2:8-9)

10. And the angel said to them, "Be not afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of a great joy which will come to all the people. For to you is born this day in the City of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."

2. After three days they found him in the Temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.
whom you found in the Temple. (Lk 2:46)
3. And when they saw him they were astonished; and his Mother said to him, "Son, why have you treated us so? Behold, your father and I have been looking for you anxiously."
whom you found in the Temple. (Lk 2:48)
4. And he said to them, "How is it that you sought me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?" And they did not understand the saying which he spoke to them.
whom you found in the Temple. (Lk 2:49-50)
5. One thing have I asked of the Lord, that I will seek after: that I may dwell in the House of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord and to inquire in his Temple.
whom you found in the Temple. (Ps 27:4)
6. And the Temple, which a little while before was full of fear and disturbance, was filled with joy and gladness, now that the Almighty Lord had appeared.
whom you found in the Temple. (2 Mc 3:30)
7. The eternal God is your dwelling place, and underneath are the everlasting arms.
whom you found in the Temple. (Dt 33:27)
8. Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised in the city of our God!
...Within her citadels God has shown himself a sure defense.
whom you found in the Temple. (Ps 48:1, 3)
9. On the holy mountain stands the city he founded; the Lord loves the gates of Zion more than all the dwelling places of Jacob.
whom you found in the Temple. (Ps 87:1-2)
10. And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine upon it, for the glory of God is its light, and its lamp is the Lamb.

1. Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth is to pass over before you into the Jordan.
whom was baptized by John. (Jos 3:11)
2. When Jesus was baptized, he went up immediately from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened, and [John] saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him.
whom was baptized by John. (Mt 3:16)
3. On that day, all the fountains of the great deep burst forth, and the windows of the heavens were opened.

4. And lo, a voice from heaven, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

2. When the wine failed, the Mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine."

3. Thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, "Every jar shall be filled with wine."
who revealed His glory at your request. (Jer 13:12)
4. And the royal wine was lavished according to the bounty of the king.
who revealed His glory at your request. (Est 1:7)
5. The steward of the feast called the bridegroom and said to him, "Every man serves the good wine first...; but you have kept the good wine until now."
who revealed His glory at your request. (Jn 2:9-10)
6. This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory; and his disciples believed in him.
who revealed His glory at your request. (Jn 2:11)
7. With great delight I sat in his shadow, and his fruit was sweet to my taste. He brought me in to the wine cellar, and his banner over me was love.
who revealed His glory at your request. (Song 2:3-4)
8. The Lord of Hosts will make for all peoples a feast of fat things, a feast of wine on the lees, well refined.
who revealed His glory at your request. (Is 25:6)
9. The Lord answered and said to his people, "Behold, I am sending you grain, wine, and oil, and you will be satisfied."
who revealed His glory at your request. (Jl 2:18)
10. For there shall be a sowing of peace; the vine shall yield its fruit, and the ground shall give its increase, and the heavens shall give their dew.
who revealed His glory at your request. (Zec 8:12)

4. Come now, let us reason together, says the Lord: though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool.
who preached the Kingdom and forgiveness of sins. (Is 1:18)
5. Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go forth from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you."
who preached the Kingdom and forgiveness of sins. (Gen 12:1)
6. And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying, "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

7. Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent, and believe in the gospel."

who preached the Kingdom and forgiveness of sins. (Ps 69:9)
9. The Lord has anointed me to bring good tidings to the poor.

10. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound.
who preached the Kingdom and forgiveness of sins. (Is 61:2)

THE TRANSFIGURATION

2. Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.

3. Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves.
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Mk 9:2)
4. And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his garments became white as light.
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Mt 17:2)
5. Philip found Nathaniel and said to him, "We have found him of whom Moses in the law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Jn 1:45)
6. And behold two men spoke with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus, which he was about to accomplish in Jerusalem.
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Lk 9:30-31)*
7. He was still speaking when lo, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Mt 17:5)
8. When the disciples heard this they fell on their faces, and were filled with awe.
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Mt 17:6)
9. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and have no fear."
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Mt 17:7)
10. Bless the Lord, O my soul! O Lord my God, thou art very great! Thou art clothed with honor and majesty, who coverest thyself with light as with a garment.
who was transfigured on Mount Tabor. (Ps 104:1-2)

2. For from the rising of the sun to its setting my name is great among the nations, and in every place incense is offered to my name, and a pure offering.
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Mal 1:11)
3. And he did not lay his hand on the chief men of the People of Israel; they beheld God, and ate and drank.
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Ex 24:11)
4. And he rained down upon them manna to eat, and gave them the grain of heaven. Man ate of the bread of angels.
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Ps 78:24-25)
5. When it was evening, he sat at table with the twelve disciples.
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Mt 26:20)
6. And he said, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer."
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Lk 22:15)
7. And he took bread, and when he had given thanks he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body which is given for you.
Do this in remembrance of me."
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Lk 22:19)
8. And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you; for this is my Blood of the new covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins."
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Mt 26:27-28)*
9. "For my Flesh is food indeed, and my Blood is drink indeed. He who eats my Flesh and drinks my Blood abides in me, and I in him."
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Jn 6:55-56)
10. And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.
who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. (Acts 2:42)

The Five Sorrowful Mysteries

THE FIRST SORROWFUL MYSTERY THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN

Hail Mary full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed are thou among women and blest is the fruit of they womb Jesus, *in agony in the garden for us.
